Later she became a prostitute and homeless drug addict on the streets of Washington, DC.

Lisa saw the light and overcame her guilt, shame, and remorse. By devoting herself to dispelling the idea of throwaway lives, Lisa has been able to motivate, inspire, and help men and women, drug addicts, alcoholics, and offenders not only believe that second chances are possible, but attainable.
