- · Add on scholarship (above & beyond standard institutional aid)
- · For a duration of up to 4 years as an undergraduate student

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a resident of the state of Michigan
- Applicant must be a first-time college freshman with a high school GPA of 2.8 (unweighted) or above; and an ACT score of 22 or above, or a SAT score of 1100 or above, who is accepted for admission at Ave Maria University for Fall 2018 (May NOT be a returning AMU student)
- Applicant must be a practicing Catholic (endorsement letter from parish)
- Maintain a university GPA of at least a 2.5 to keep scholarship
